


Housing Tenure

- In 2016, 70.8% of all households in Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry owned their dwelling.
- In 2016, the percentage of renters in Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry was 29.1%, compared to 33.4% in the Ottawa-Gatineau CMA, 30.2% in Ontario and 31.8% in Canada.
- While all the other lower tier geographies owned from 77.9% to 88.4% of all dwelling, Cornwall owned only 54.7% of its dwelling.
- South Stormont, South Glengarry and North Stormont owned 88.4%, 87.3% and 86.9% of all households respectively.



Housing Suitability, Adequacy and Affordability

- In 2016, 8.2% of households in Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry reported that their dwelling was in need of major repairs compared to 5.68% in Ottawa-Gatineau CMA, 6.1% in Ontario and 6.5% in Canada.
- 24.3% of Households in Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry spent 30% or more of 2015 total income on shelter costs, compared to 22.5% in Ottawa-Gatineau CMA, 27.7% in Ontario and 24.1% in Canada.



Housing Cost

- In 2016, the average monthly housing cost for owned dwellings in Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry was \$1,051, compared to \$1,424 in Ottawa-Gatineau CMA, \$1,463 in Ontario and \$1,313 in Canada.
- In 2016, the average monthly housing cost for rented dwellings in Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry was \$814, compared to \$1,066 in Ottawa-Gatineau CMA, \$1,109 in Ontario and \$1,002 in Canada.
- The average monthly housing cost for owned dwellings was highest in North Dundas (\$1,259) and lowest in Cornwall (\$932).
- The average monthly housing cost for rented dwellings was highest in South Stormont (\$1,024) and lowest in Cornwall (\$788).
