Council News

United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry

Information Technology Review Presented

Ben Perry, Perry Group Consulting Limited, provided report and recommendations on the Information Technology Review completed for the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry. Recommendations, together with staff report, will be considered at the November meeting of Council.

Election of Warden

Ian McLeod and Evonne Deleгарde were nominated for the position of Warden for 2018. An election was conducted, and with the vote remaining tied after the second ballot, Ian McLeod's name was drawn to be the Warden for SDG for 2018.

Setback Authorized

Council approved a setback of 20 m from the centerline of County Road 3 for the proposed construction of a garage on Lot 13, Concession 2, Township of North Dundas.

Resolution—Bill 148

Council endorsed resolution from the Township of Montague concerning Bill 148 Fair Workplaces, Better Jobs Act. Bill 148, if passed, has large financial implications, specifically as it relates to municipal volunteer firefighters.

Tender/Quotation

Council accepted proposal from Amec Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure, to provide the County with Meteorological and Information Technology Services to support the County's Weather Information System (RWIS) for a 40 -month contract at a cost of \$15,986. per year.

Key Information

Clerk Thomson advised Council the Agreement with LAS was renewed for Closed Meeting Investigator Services.

Director of Finance Metcalfe provided public notice of budget meeting set for December 4th, 2017 and advised Council of the resignation of the Municipal Prosecutor.
