Resolution—Paramedics

Council passed resolution supporting the maintenance of the existing collective bargaining process for paramedics until such time as the Province amends the binding arbitration process to require arbitrators to consider local ability to pay.

Cornwall Regional Airport

Council authorized staff to file, with no further action, the request for the County to become involved in the Cornwall Regional Airport.

Committee Appointments

Council appointed Margaret MacDonald and Amy Kroeze as the lay members to the SDG Regional Incentives Implementation Committee.

MTO Detour Route

Council supported the Ministry of Transportation's request to utilize County Road 2 from Lancaster to Curry Hill as a detour route during the replacement of the County Road 2/34 overpass.
